Update - New requirements for passengers entering Panama



Update

- The option of having tests upon arrival has been eliminated.
- Exceptions apply for children under 5 years of age.

The health authorities of the Republic of Panama through Decree N°102 of July, 1st, 2022, have established new measures for nationals, residents, or foreigners entering the country.

Requirements for passengers entering Panama as of July 15th, 2022:

1. All passengers must present **mandatory**, prior to boarding, the digital Health Affidavit registered on the website <u>Panama Digital</u>.

2. Vaccinated Passengers

 They should present a vaccination card with a complete vaccination scheme or at least two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine according to the vaccination program approved by the country of origin.

3. Non-Vaccinated Passengers

- Submit a negative PCR or antigen COVID -19 test performed up to 72 hours prior to arrival in Panama.
- Children under 5 years of age are exempt from any type of COVID-19 testing if their parents, guardians, or caregivers have a complete vaccination schedule or a negative COVID-19 test result.
