

Brunei Darussalam's Travel Requirements Checklist

Effective 15 September 2022

Updated Mask policy on RB Flights



As per the updated regulations by Brunei government, effective 15 September 2022, the use of face masks onboard RB flights is **no longer mandatory** with the following exceptions:

- · for guests travelling to a country/destination where face mask is required,
- · and/or for guests exhibiting symptoms of an infection

For passengers continuing their journey after Brunei International Airport, please ensure you have the following:

All travellers to adhere to any other requirements set by the destination country

OTHER THINGS TO NOTE

- No vaccination requirements for entering or leaving Brunei Darussalam.
- Not required to complete Arrival Declaration Form prior to leaving for Brunei Darussalam.
 - Post-arrival COVID-19 tests are not required for all travellers.
