THE NEW EUROPEAN TARIFF CONCEPT

More choice thanks to greater fare variety on short- and medium-haul routes

(April 23, 2026)

The airlines of the Lufthansa Group* will introduce a revised fare structure within Europe **on April 28, 2026** (date of ticket issue), thus creating an offer that is even more geared to different customer needs. Economy **Basic** is a **new entry-level fare**, while the **existing fares are being revised in a targeted manner**.

The new fare structure offers more choice and makes it possible to choose the fare that best suits individual requirements for each trip – from price-oriented options to maximum flexibility. All fares can add services on demand, so that travellers only pay for the services they actually need.

The new tariff concept for Europe – what will change?

First things first: Regardless of the fare selected, the comfort on board remains unchanged in both Economy Class and Business Class. Passengers will continue to enjoy the usual level on board as they know it from the Lufthansa Group airlines.

New tariff names provide better orientation:

- Economy Classic → **Economy Comfort**
- Economy Green → **Economy Comfort Green**
- Business Saver → **Business Comfort**
- Business Green → **Business Comfort Green**

Adjusted scope of services in selected tariffs:

- **Economy Light:** can now be rebooked for a fee
- **Economy Comfort:** Seat reservation only for a fee
- **Economy Comfort Green:** Seat reservation only for a fee, rebookable for a fee

- **Economy Flex:** free seat reservation only possible for a Classic Seat
- **Business Comfort:** only one piece of baggage allowance (up to a maximum of 32 kg)
- **Business Comfort Green:** only one piece of free baggage (up to max. 32 kg), can no longer be rebooked

Information on rebooking existing tickets from 28 April 2026

If a ticket issued up to and including April 27, 2026 in **the Economy Classic, Economy Green or Economy Flex** fares is rebooked, associated ASR EMDs can also be rebooked, even if the new fare no longer includes free seat reservation.

In the event of rebooking of a ticket issued up to and including 27 April 2026 in the **Business Green** fare, the new baggage allowance will apply if calculated on the basis of the current fare (e.g. when rebooking the outbound flight), while the old baggage allowance of two pieces of baggage up to 32 kg each will remain unchanged if calculated on the basis of the historical fare (e.g. when rebooking the return flight).
